

We're counting down to the 44th Annual Exhibit, and I hear the familiar buzz. We'll again welcome members of our Bonsai community and their families and friends. For some of you, this will be your first exhibit. Prepare to be inspired. For many of you, this will be an extended family reunion—and something you look forward to year after year. I know I do. Prepare to be re-energized.

I am very aware that getting ready for Annual Exhibit is nearly a year-round effort. And I want to thank you for all you do to prepare — and how you put your heart into hosting a great event for our members. You always bring out our best. The strength of our membership—commitment to each other—sets us apart from all other bonsai organizations.

Annual Exhibit reminds us (every year!) that what makes us great is not any single individual or any one idea, but the work of all of us – day in and day out – who make this organization extraordinary. Then, we invite members to bring in trees for Colin to work on. These trees are limited to conifers with preference toward pines, yews and spruces. Colin will select trees for demonstration based on their teaching potential. Bring any trees that you are willing to put in the selection pool. Time permitting Colin will get to many of these trees, however your tree may not be chosen. This lecture/ demonstration is available to everyone but only members can provide trees. Following the demonstration we will have a banquet so we can enjoy each other's company and share our welcoming attitude with Colin. Following the banquet, everyone is welcome to participate in a fundraising raffle.

Sunday morning we have another excellent opportunity to obtain material suitable for our area, a yew, and



work with an outstanding bonsai artist. The afternoon workshop is a small Bring Your Own material, take a look at one of your own trees with the artist of transformation and come up with a new unique style, or advance the tree along its current path with Colin Lewis's guidance.
